12530 Broad Street. Built ca. 1834.
Original Owner: Wilson Bird (1787-1868).
Current Owner: Rebecca Johnson.



STOP 3.

Hancock County Court House.
Courthouse Square. Built 1881-83.
Use Broad Street entrance.

STOP 4.

Terrell-Stone House. 9705 Jones Street (Hwy Ga-15). Built 1822.
Original Owner: Dr. William Terrell (1786-1855).
Current Owners: Rick and Mauriel Joslyn.
